THE NASTAR CENTER TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Welcome! To reserve your spot in the NASTAR Center Training Course you must meet and complete the requirements below and return the attached forms.

1. The NASTAR Center Booking Form

- This form reserves a spot for you in the class.
 - A minimum 25% deposit is required to secure the booking.
 - Final payment is due no later than 30 days prior to class start date.
 - The NASTAR Center can provide clients with a receipt of transaction if requested.

2. The Notice & Disclaimer, Waiver of Liability, & Emergency Contact Forms

- These forms notify the NASTAR Center of any medical condition(s) prior to training.

3. The NASTAR Center Health Requirements:

- Space Simulator Requirements
 - Max Height: 6'7" or 77 inches (196cm)
 - Max Weight: 310 lbs. (141kg)
 - Min Age: 18 years and above
- Altitude Chamber Requirements
 - Free of illnesses, severe allergies and afflictions that could be aggravated by atmospheric pressure changes.
 - No scuba diving activities within 24 hours preceding training date.
 - Participants must be clean-shaven or may not be permitted to participate in the chamber flight.

4. The NASTAR Center Medical Requirements

- Obtain Valid FAA Medical Certificate Form 8500-8 (class 1, 2 or 3 accepted) or NASA JSC Form 708 is accepted. Follow these steps to obtain your Certification
 1. Visit the following website: www.faa.gov/pilots/amelocator/
 - **If you Pass Exam:** Client will receive an FAA Medical Certificate
 - ❖ **WHAT WE NEED:** Bring the original FAA Medical Certificate to the NASTAR Center when you arrive for training.
 - **If you do NOT pass Exam:** You are NOT automatically disqualified from training. Ask the AME physician for the copy of your FAA Form 8500-8 (front and back) paperwork with a written explanation indicating restriction. A NASTAR Center physician will evaluate the paperwork and inform you if you can still participate.
 - ❖ **WHAT WE NEED:** A copy of your FAA Form 8500-8 faxed or emailed to the NASTAR Center (ex. Vision, mild antidepressants are common)
- Recent (within two years) ECG/EKG test (**Only for clients 40 years of age and older)
 1. Ask your AME physician during your FAA Medical Exam to perform this test, or
 2. Perform a new test with your primary physician.
 - ❖ **WHAT WE NEED:** Bring a copy of your ECG/EKG test to the NASTAR Center when you arrive for training.

NOTE: THE NASTAR CENTER MUST RECEIVE ALL COMPLETED FORMS RETURNED NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE COURSE DATE TO RESERVE YOUR SPOT. Please email them to info@NASTARCenter.com or fax them to (267) 989-1251.

THE NASTAR CENTER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Terms of Payment

- a. All programs require an initial 25% deposit of the total program price and a completed Reservation Form to formally accept and hold your reservation.
- b. The complete payment is due 30 days prior to the scheduled event date along with the other completed forms.

2. Cancellation Policy

- a. Notification of cancellation must be received in writing by the NASTAR Center.
- b. The following cancellation penalties apply:
 - Up until 60 days to event date – 100% refund of deposit minus a processing fee equivalent to 5% of the deposit. Reservations can be rebooked.
 - Between 30 and 60 days to event date – 25% cancellation fee of the deposit. Reservations can be rebooked.
 - Less than 30 days to event date – 50% cancellation fee of the full payment.
 - Less than 15 days to event date – 100% cancellation fee of the full payment.

3. Changes and Substitutions

- a. Participant name change substitution is allowed provided he/she meets program eligibility and prerequisites for the program
- b. All other changes within 30 days of the event date are not possible.

4. Eligibility

Participation in the NASTAR Center Space Programs is for participants eighteen years of age and older unless otherwise stated in the specific program information. All NASTAR Center programs require a current FAA Medical Certificate, NASA JSC Form 708, or approval from the NASTAR Center physician unless otherwise stated.

The NASTAR Center reserves the right to decline acceptance of any individual as a program participant for any reason whatsoever. Under no circumstances can reservations be sold or resold, and under no other circumstances is the NASTAR Center obliged or obligated to allow the transferability of the reservation.

5. Group Size

We accept reservations on a first-come, first-served basis. All programs have a minimum group size of 5 people unless otherwise stated. The NASTAR Center is willing to run programs with smaller group numbers provided the minimum equivalent payment is made.

6. Program Modifications

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ's)

What Should I Bring to the NASTAR Center?

1. Passport (Non-US) or Drivers License (US) required.
2. Valid FAA Medical Certificate (or international equivalent)
3. Camera or video camera
4. Lock (if needed) for securing items in the NASTAR Center lockers

Dress Code / What Should I Wear to the NASTAR Center?

Dress each day in comfortable clothing. You will receive a flight suit which can be worn over your clothing. Closed toed shoes or sneakers are mandatory. No sandals or high-heels are permitted. Glasses and contacts are ok. Lockers are provided for storing personal belongings.

What Do I Receive as Part of the Training Course?

Your training program will include academic courses, flights in our Phoenix centrifuge and Altitude Chamber (only if enrolled in the Suborbital Scientist Training Program), an award ceremony, and souvenir keepsakes.

Is there a Souvenir Shop Available?

Yes. Additional souvenir items are available for purchase at the NASTAR Center gift shop on site.

Does My Training Program Include Lunch?

Directions From Center City Philadelphia

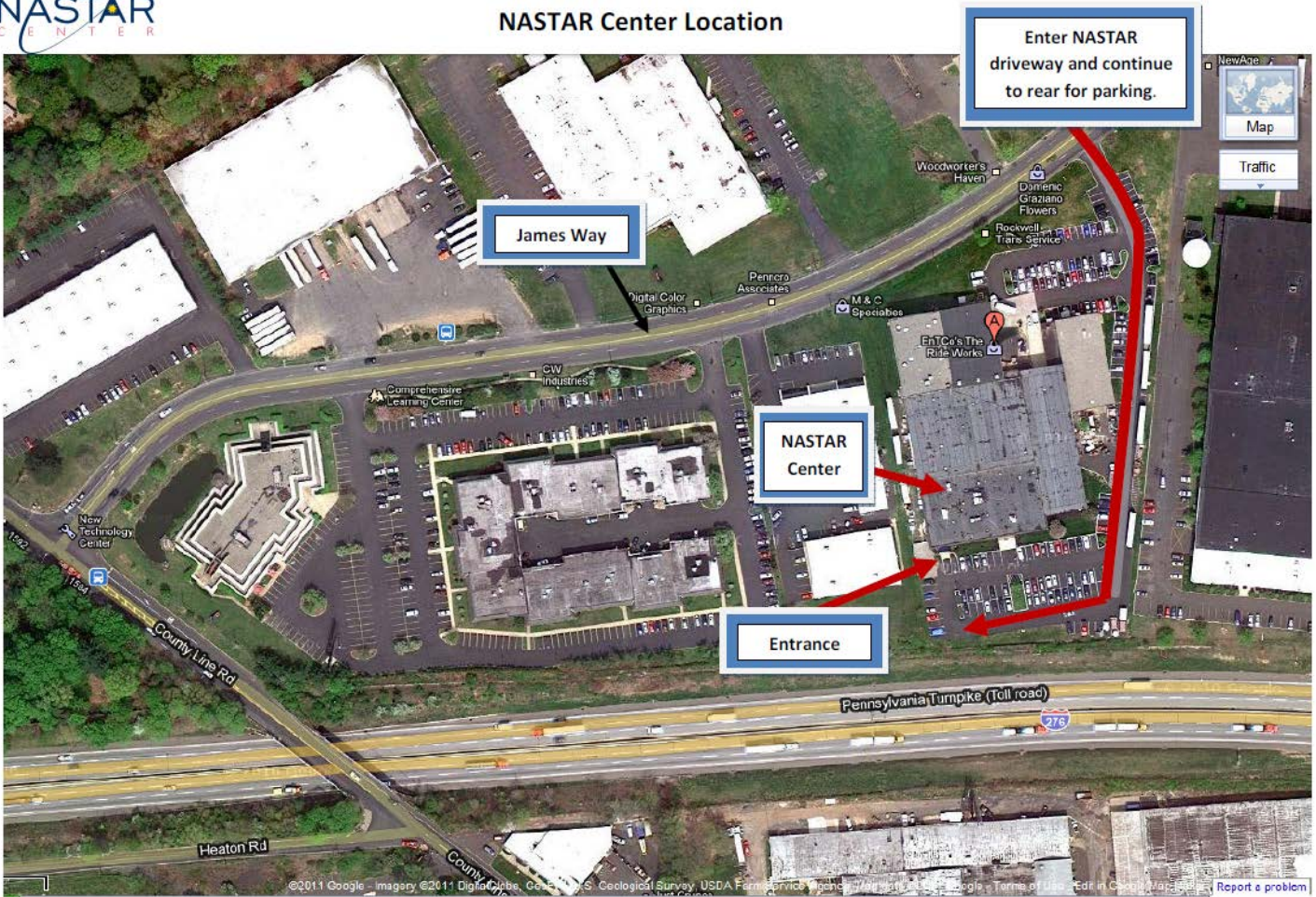
1. Take 95 North to Street Road Exit - 132 West.

Directions From Philadelphia International Airport

1. Upon exiting Airport, take I-95 North. Continue North on I-95 for approx. 25-30 miles.
2. Get off at the Street Road Exit (Rte. 132 West). At the top of the ramp turn left.
3. Continue on Street Road approx. 9 miles. Pass through Feasterville, and then come into Southampton.
4. Take Route. 232 South (turn left) at traffic light, (Route. 232 also called Second Street Pike.) Go to the traffic light and turn right onto Knowles Avenue.
5. Continue on Knowles Avenue and behind the shopping center for approx. 1/2 mile.
6. This road will merge with / turn into James Way.
7. ETC is the second drive on the left. Take the drive up to the front of the building. It faces the PA turnpike. Visitor's parking is at the lobby entrance.
